Discussions with NWG members highlighted a strong interest among safeguarding partnerships in exploring future-focused responses to Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE).

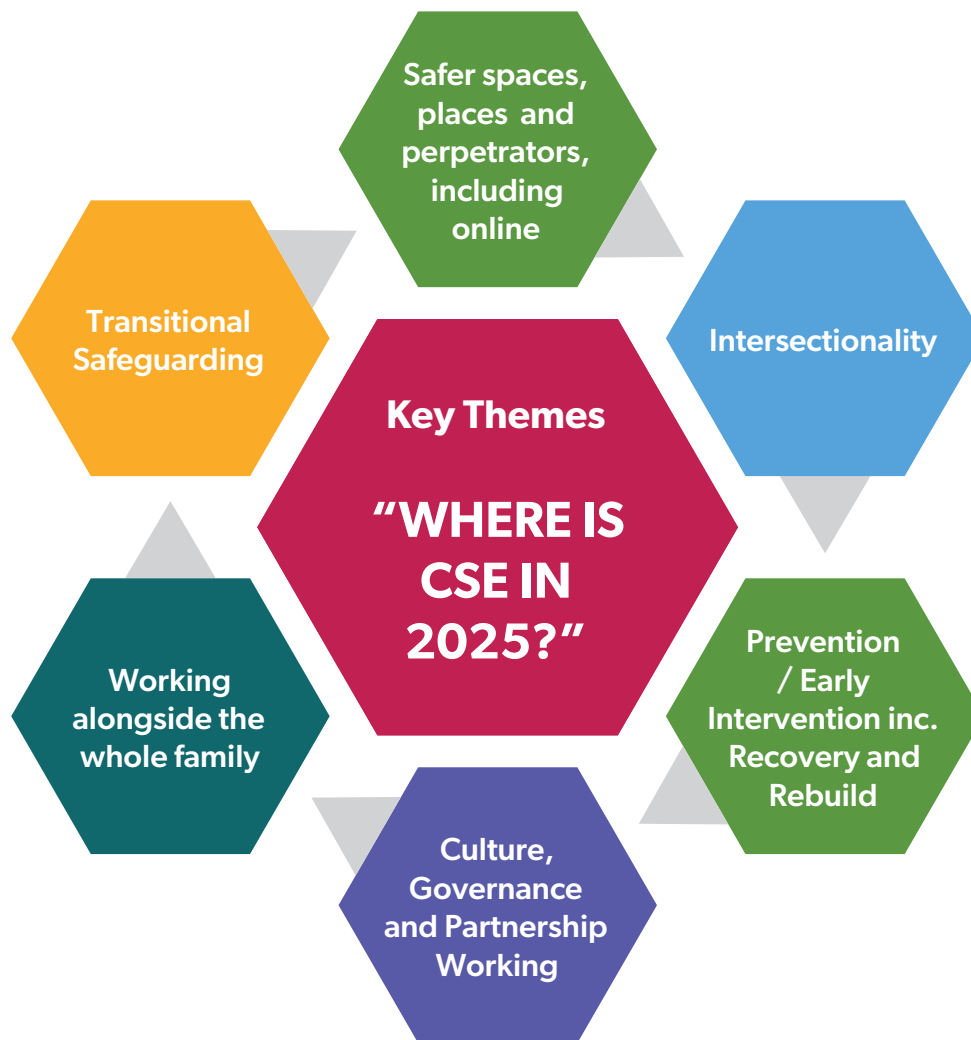
